
A Strategic Framework to Prevent Plastic Pollution

DEFOSSILIZE

Plastics by Replacing Oil and Gas with Renewable Carbon Sources

Rationale: All three approaches are needed; a single strategy by itself won't solve the plastics crisis. That's why everyone should support progress on each front. Reducing the production of petrochemical plastics can address all three concerns at once.

Ensure a JUST TRANSITION for workers and communities whose livelihood now depends on petrochemical plastics.

Rationale: It's not enough to promote technical solutions for a more sustainable future. To build support and reduce resistance to change, a transition pathway must be provided through meaningful policies with generous funding.
